More paws, less stress

Welcoming dogs into the workplace is not just a contemporary trend - it's genuinely good for our mental health. Supporting the evidence from numerous earlier studies around the world, research in 2019 from the University of Lincoln shows that taking dogs to work has positive impacts both for organisations and for their employees, particularly with regard to mental health and wellbeing.

Professor David Mills, Professor of Veterinary Behavioural Medicine at the University of Lincoln and a co-author of the research paper¹, says,

If you told employers there was a simple way to increase their workforce's overall satisfaction with the working conditions, they'd be very keen to learn more. Our results show that far from being a distraction, (a fear expressed by some in our earlier work) allowing dogs in the workplace has the potential to improve employees' focus and probably productivity too. Forward-thinking companies should consider very seriously whether they can accommodate dogs in the workplace.

With blue-chip organisations like Virgin, Nestlé, UniCredit and McCann promoting the value of dog-friendly workplaces, it's clear that the practice brings compelling benefits for the wellbeing of both employees and businesses alike.

Our own **RGS Dog-in-Chief**, **Millie**, couldn't agree more. She spends her working days keeping our teams smiling and easing the occasional furrowed brow.


